Need for training:

The delays in the Cyprus Judiciary system, that cause abuse of the system and a waste of the court's system, lead to the increased use of arbitration as the main alternative dispute resolution method in Cyprus. Traditionally arbitration as a means of dispute resolution has been used since 1944 when the Cyprus Domestic Arbitration law (CAP 4) was enacted. Arbitration is used as an alternative dispute resolution method in several sectors of the economy such as construction, shipping, finance and commerce. The need arises from the Legislation CAP 4 itself.

The program, will provide a detailed analysis of the legislation and the rules of arbitration existing in Cyprus, it will explain the general principles of arbitration and its relationship to other dispute resolution methods and will refer to the procedure from the appointment through to the issue of the award, with reference on the structure of the award and the recognition and enforcement of the award.
